



The cultural action program 12miradas in collaboration with Riverside, a project of social commitment of Hijos de Rivera to promote art and creativity, convenes its first international workshop in Mana Contemporary NJ by the Galician artist Antonio Murado.

Workshop with Antonio Murado

From October 4 to 9, 2019

Mana Contemporary NJ

This workshop will be led by artist Antonio Murado, considered one of the most internationally renowned Spanish painters of his generation.

Artist Antonio Murado (Lugo, Galicia, 1964) has lived and worked in the US for more than twenty years. He took part in 12Miradas::Riverside's 2017 program of urban events.

This time around, for our third year, we are taking the project abroad for the first time, with the help of New Jersey's Mana Contemporary.

Twelve students funded by the Hijos de Rivera Corporation and selected by the artist (six of them Spanish citizens or residents, and six of them US citizens or residents) will engage in a collaborative artistic process alongside Murado for one week in October 2019.

The workshop is aimed at visual and decorative arts professionals.



Antonio Murado (Lugo, Galicia 1964; BFA University of Salamanca) early on caught the attention of the Spanish art scene, taking center stage in a number of important prizes and juried exhibitions. His relationship with New York began in 1995, when he received the Unión Fenosa - MACUF Artists Abroad Grant, eventually settling in the city for good.

Considered by critics as one of the most internationally renowned Spanish painters, his work has been shown in both solo and group shows in Germany, Canada, the United States and elsewhere. His work can be found in important international collections such as New York's Philip Morris Collection and American Express Collection, or Barcelona's LaCaixa Collection of Contemporary Art

Applications will be received from July 1 to July 31, 2019. Successful applicants will subsequently be informed as to how to complete their registration, and will be sent all other relevant details for the workshop.
